BICYCLE TASMANIA BIG RIDE, 13 NOVEMBER 2011

Conditional permission is granted for Bicycle Tasmania to conduct the Big Ride on Sunday 13/11/11. This will incorporate two rides : the Tinderbox Loop and the longer Channel Loop. Although all cyclists will be expected to be self sufficient on the ride, a Bicycle Tasmania volunteer will follow the last riders in case they need assistance.

Both events will leave Dru Point, Margate at 9.00am, with the total event expected to finish about 5.00pm. It is anticipated that approximately 100 riders will participate in the Big Ride.

As the permit holder you, Mr Canning, will be responsible for ensuring the conditions of the permit (as set out hereunder) are adhered to and the event is conducted in a safe manner.

It is a condition of this permit that :

- participants are advised to adhere to all road rules;
- marshals and warning signs are positioned on all junctions to warn traffic approaching the event route;
- marshals and warnings signs are positioned at the start and finish of the event and regularly throughout the route of the event, to warn motorists of the event in progress;
- every rider must have a rear flashing bicycle light which must be turned on in the event of any inclement weather;
- all matters outlined in your permit application are adhered to;
- if any incident involving a pedestrian or vehicle should occur, you should notify Sergeant Penny Reardon, Southern Traffic Services (6230 2260) of the matter within three (3) days of the conclusion of the event.

Tasmania Police will provide passing attention during the event and will respond to any incident that is reported.

Any rider not adhering to the road rules may well be proceeded against by police.
